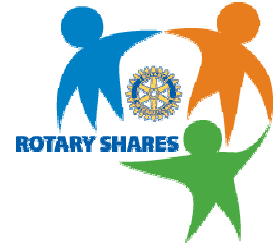

- Offer a Special Program intended to help Military students earn academic credits toward the CCAF Associate Degree
- Provide Continuing Education Courses for Career Development and / or Personnel Enrichment
- Associate of Arts and Associate of Science Degrees that are accepted at Public two and four year colleges and universities
- Campuses in Bishopville, Camden, Manning and Sumter County

- Semester 16 weeks
- Day classes
- Evening classes
- Online classes
- Variety of financial aid is available to include Pell Grant and South Carolina Education Lottery Scholarship Money.

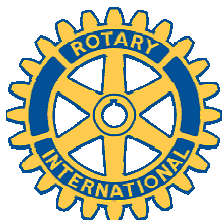
