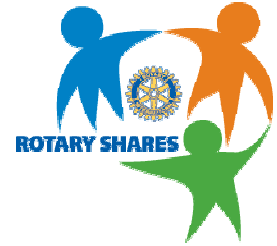

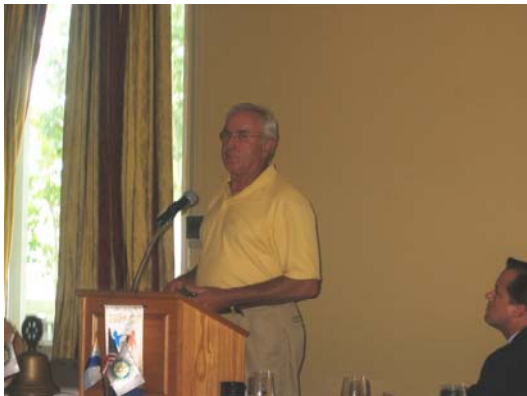
TODAY'S PROGRAM

Our speaker was John Long, CFO of East Coast Ethanol LLC. The Columbia-based company plans to build four new ethanol plants in the Southeast, including one plant in Chester County that could bring 45 new jobs and millions of dollars of investment into the state.

John said that the demand for ethanol has risen along with fuel prices, giving alternatives to gasoline more economic viability. He told us that because East Coast Ethanol sees the Southeast as the destination for most if not all of its product, the company thinks producing ethanol from shipped corn will pay off.

John said their mission is to construct and operate four 110 Million Gallon corn-ethanol plants in the southeast region of the United States. They expect to become one of the foremost suppliers of ethanol to the southeast U.S. market. The company will use its strategic locations to provide fuel ethanol to terminals along the eastern seaboard while providing distillers grains and carbon dioxide for farms and industry. The company will also work cooperatively with local communities to assure an environmentally-sound and profitable business utilizing the latest technology to assure a clean, efficient and dependable source of ethanol to assist our country in reducing its dependence on foreign oil.

Anyone interested in investing in East Coast Ethanol, the prospectus calls for a minimum investment of \$15,000 for the first unit and \$5,000 for each one-third unit of investment thereafter. You may visit their website at www.eastcoastethanol.us.

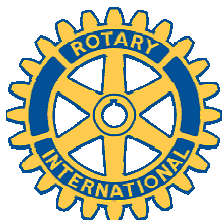
