Jeanie Crotts recently participated in a mission trip to Guatemala with two of her college girlfriends. The trip was sponsored by the Cooperative for Education (CoEd), a Cincinnati based non-profit organization

dedicated to breaking the cycle of poverty in Guatemala by providing textbooks and educational opportunities to under-privileged schoolchildren.

CoEd also partners with North American & Guatemalan Rotary clubs in the Guatemala Literacy Project, an initiative that provides badly-needed textbooks, library materials, and computer labs to underprivileged children in Guatemala.

During the five-day trip, Jeanie's group toured several very remote and poor villages, visiting schools and homes. The group distributed school supplies and met with the school children. In many of the villages, the entire town turned out to thank the CoEd group.

One of the girlfriends on the trip with Jeanie was Karen Pompeo, a professor at USC-Sumter and wife of Rotarian Mike Pompeo.

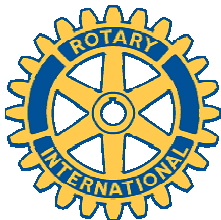
